After the pool is filled the pump and filtration system can be serviced to ensure everything is in working order then the water will need up to two weeks of treatment before it is safe for swimming. Pool keys are available from the office from now until the last day of school. For those community members who aren't part of the telephone fundraising effort the cost of a key is \$100 (\$50 refundable bond and \$50 use of the pool).
